

**SASKATCHEWAN REAL ESTATE COMMISSION
BRANCH MANAGER, ASSOCIATE BROKER OR SALESPERSON
REGISTRATION APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**



Attached is a Branch Manager, Associate Broker or Salesperson application form. To become registered, you must accurately complete this form and **provide it to the broker at the brokerage with whom you wish to become registered. It is the broker's responsibility to log-in on-line and process your registration.** This form is to be completed by those individuals registering for the first time, by those currently registered and changing brokerages and by those applying for reinstatement of their registration after a period of absence. To be qualified as a branch manager or associate broker in the Province of Saskatchewan, you must have passed the provincial qualifying exams and have been actively employed as a salesperson for a period of two years during the preceding five years OR has related education and/or experience that, in the opinion of the Commission, is equivalent to the education and/or experience prescribed in the Act and bylaws.

To be qualified as a salesperson in the Province of Saskatchewan, you must have passed the provincial qualifying exam(s) and obtained a criminal record check by fingerprint comparison OR has related education that, in the opinion of the Commission, is equivalent to the education prescribed in the bylaws.

5. Copy of your Bankruptcy Statement of Affairs and a copy of the Absolute Order of Discharge or the Notice of Pending Discharge.
6. Provide the name of the regulatory body that made payment on your behalf, describe the circumstances that caused the payment and state any disciplinary action that was taken.
7. Copy of your criminal record and a letter detailing the circumstances of each violation.
8. Upon signature of this document, the Saskatchewan Real Estate Commission has authority to verify all the above statements.

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The broker of the brokerage where you will be registered must complete this section. Please note that if the brokerage has a branch office previously registered with the Saskatchewan Real Estate Commission, the brokerage has been assigned a branch ID # that must be used to identify the office location for the applicant.
